Learn a new skill and a new story in the Bible.



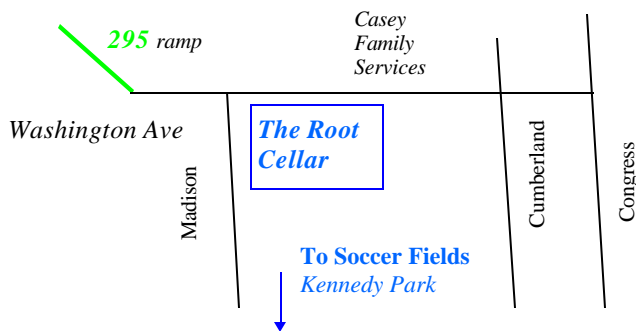

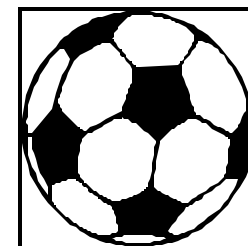

- **Crafts** and **music** are great tools to make lessons come alive for little ones, so we will have something for your child each day.
- Snacks will be provided since children learn best without grumbling tummies.
